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OVERVIEW OF VILLAGES

BIRKFELD

The many excursion destinations on offer such as the „Feistritztalbahn“ (Feistritz Valley Railway), „Klangtunnel“ exhibition (Sound Tunnel) and Felber Chocolate Factory make this village a popular spot for the whole family.

FISCHBACH

Fischbach is known for its Easter Bunny celebrations and its credentials as a ‘village in bloom’. It is also a high-altitude health resort and therefore a wonderful area for hiking. In particular the mystical „Teufelstein“ (Devil’s Stone) attracts many hikers, not only for the winter solstice hike!

MIESENBACH

The „Wildwiese“ with its lookout post is probably one of the most popular excursion destinations in Miesenbach, particularly during hiking season. Hiking trails such as the „Wasserweg“ (Water Trail) and „Klammweg“ (Gorge Trail) will delight walkers immeasurably.

RATTEN

The biggest high-alpine wind farm in Central Europe today lies in this former mining village – a stunning hiking destination near the Pretul mountain. The Brass Music Museum and Mining Museum offer plenty of interesting material for culture seekers.

RETTENECK

At the foot of the Stuhleck lies the village of Rettenegg. Feel reinvigorated either by a visit to the „Labyrinth Mensch“ exhibition, on a stroll along the „Planetenweg“ (Planet Trail) or enjoying some delicious culinary delights at the „Forellengasthof Joggland“ guesthouse – speciality fresh trout.

ST. JAKOB IM WALDE

In summer, it isn’t just the beautiful flowers or the variety of hiking opportunities that draw visitors to St. Jakob, it’s also the interactive exhibition „Kräftereich“ (Realm of Power and Energy). In winter, however, the spot is famed mainly for the „Joggland-loipe“ (Joggland cross-country skiing trail) and the „Familien-schiberg“ (Family Ski Mountain).

ST. KATHREIN AM HAUENSTEIN

Nestled amidst the „Waldheimat“ (home in the woods) area immortalised by Peter Rosegger: the Rosegger Exhibition and his favourite church are certainly worth visiting. Ski fans will enjoy the speedy descents at the Hauereck ski arena lifts.

STRALLEGG

The village of Strallegg is always a rewarding visit. The numerous hiking trails and gorgeous flowers attract guests in summer, while the alpine views from the ski lifts prove an appealing draw in winter.

VORAU

The market village of Vorau is home to the only Augustinian monastery in Styria still active, not to mention the second-largest open-air museum. For adventurers, the underground passages of „Sub Terra Vorau“ offer a very special experience.

WALDBACH-MÖNICHWALD

The village scores highly for a diverse recreational programme at any time of year: hiking on the Hochwechsel, cooling off at Freizeitsee or trips on the Hochwechsel ski lifts ensure plenty of holiday fun for all ages.

WENIGZELL

The fairy tale village of Wenigzell is renowned for its „Joggland-Oase“ (a spa centre) and the „Barfußpark“ (Barefoot Park). To round off the variety of leisure options, there are also many hiking and Nordic Walking routes available, plus culinary highlights served at establishments such as the „Bratlalm“, the „Buchtelbar“ (to sample some typical Buchteln yeast buns) and the „Schneeland“ (a beginners’ ski area).

A region once made famous by Empress Maria Theresia and the writer Peter Rosegger, and an unmissable destination in both summer and winter.

Numerous hiking trails, themed trails and walking trails will exhilarate and delight pleasure-seeking holidaymakers in summer.

Whether you'd prefer to do a leisurely family hike, a tour of the peaks or a multi-day trekking tour, there are no limits to walking enjoyment.

Another highlight in the summer months is a trip along the „Steirische Blumenstraße“ (Styrian Flower Route), possibly the most vibrant trail for the senses in Styria.

For culinary enthusiasts and those thirsting for knowledge, the region boasts museums, churches and exhibitions aplenty, plus an abundance of gourmet restaurants and wellness oases – a refreshing summer holiday is therefore assured.

In winter too, families in particular will appreciate the region's stunning landscapes and ski regions. Whether beginners or advanced, the local ski areas offer just the right terrain for everyone, with around 20 km of slopes.

Outstanding cross-country trails top off the comprehensive winter sports programme in the region.

THE STYRIAN FLOWER ROUTE „DIE STEIRISCHE BLUMENSTRASSE“

The „Steirische Blumenstraße“ links ten „flower villages“, seven of which belong to the Joglland-Waldheimat region. All the villages on this themed route have won at least one award for their floral decoration. Outwardly, the Flower Route is represented by the Royal Highnesses of the Styrian Flower Route. A trip along the most blossoming route in Styria is always well worth experiencing. The celebrated flower parade is held every two years. Numerous colourfully adorned flower wagons trundle through the villages making up the „Steirische Blumenstraße“, delighting spectators with their vibrant floral splendour.





